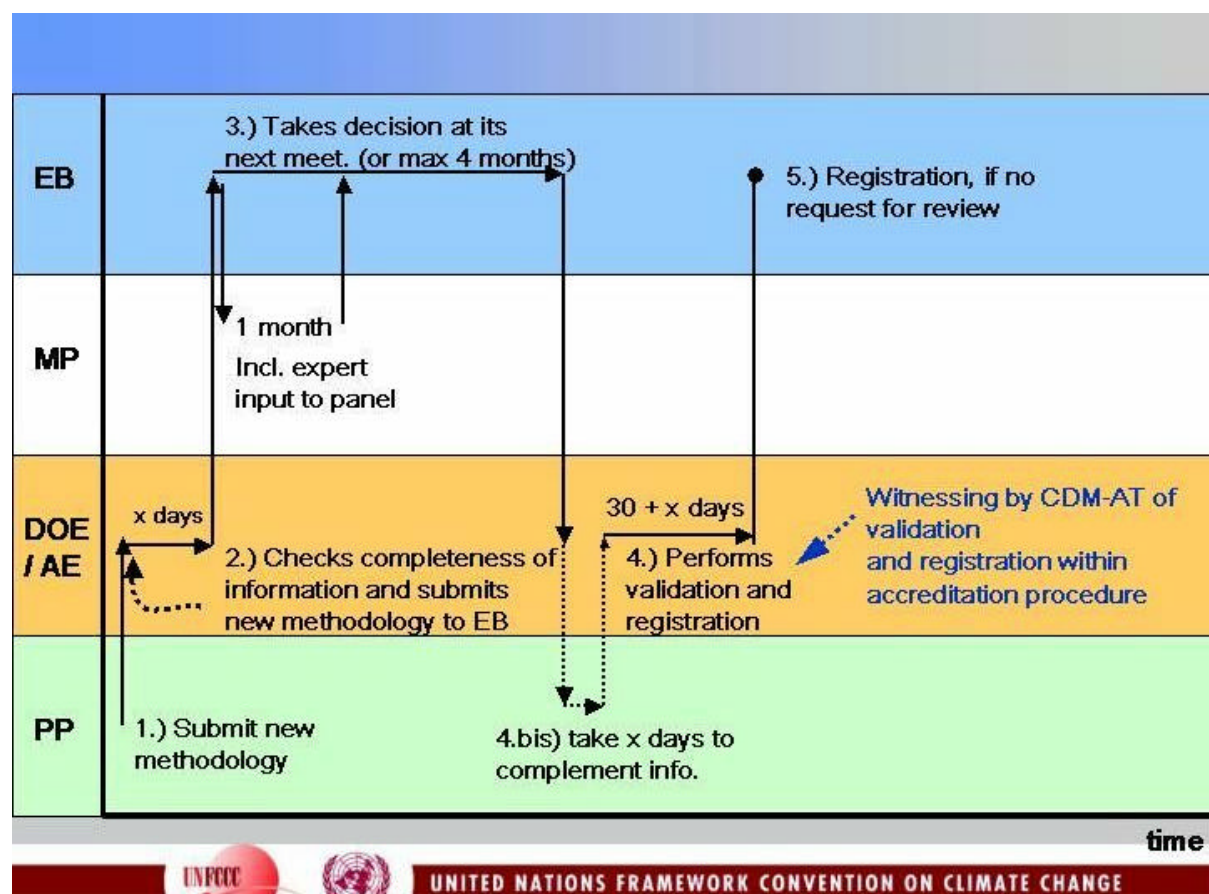


## Annex 1

The graph below describes the linkage between the process of accreditation and that of approving a new methodology. It describes steps in the process, including timelines, for submitting and approving a new methodology (baseline and/or monitoring). The graph highlights in particular that

- the witnessing of an applicant entity for validation shall take place simultaneously with the validation of an approved methodology and subsequent registration of the proposed CDM project activity.
- shows that the role of the DOE/AE at validation of a proposed methodology is limited to checking whether the documentation is complete.
- two scenarios may arise after approval of a new methodology:
  - The proposed methodology was accepted without modification. Validation can proceed immediately if all information required for validation is available;
  - The proposed methodology was modified. Validation only proceeds once project participants have adjusted their documentation. (dotted line)
