IV. Consideration of relevant methodological issues

(Agenda item 4)

- 35. The AWG-KP initiated its consideration of methodological issues, including methodologies to be applied for estimating anthropogenic emissions and the global warming potentials of GHGs, and of the possible impact thereof on the estimates of total emissions by Parties.
- 36. The AWG-KP held a workshop on 7 June 2008 on relevant methodological issues. The Vice-Chair of the AWG-KP chaired the workshop and provided a summary of the discussions⁹ (see annex VI). The AWG-KP took note of the summary of views expressed by Parties at the workshop and of views and information contained in document FCCC/KP/AWG/2008/MISC.3.
- 37. The AWG-KP agreed to continue its work, within its mandate and according to its work programme, at the first part of its sixth session, taking into account the views of Parties compiled by its Chair, as contained in annex VII, so that conclusions on these issues may be adopted at the first part of its sixth session.
