C. Emissions from fuel used for international aviation and maritime transport

(Agenda item 5 (c))

45. The SBSTA took note of the written statements provided by the International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) and the International Maritime Organization (IMO) on their continuing work on the issue of emissions from international aviation and maritime transport.

46. The SBSTA expressed appreciation for the contributions of both organizations to the work of the IPCC.

47. The SBSTA took note of the ongoing cooperation among the secretariats of the UNFCCC, ICAO and IMO, and with the IPCC, on methodological issues relating to emissions from fuel used for international aviation and maritime transport.

48. The SBSTA recalled its conclusions from its nineteenth session¹² and requested the secretariat to prepare, for the next session of the SBSTA (May 2005), information on methodological issues to update document FCCC/SBSTA/2003/INF.3.
